1 The duties of an individual board member shall be as follows:

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- 3 1. To become familiar with State school laws, regulations of the State Department of Education, and
- 4 school board policies, rules, and regulations;
- 5 2. To participate in State mandated board training;<sup>1</sup>
- 6 3. To have a general knowledge of the educational aims and objectives of the system;
- 7 4. To work harmoniously with other board members without trying either to dominate the Board or neglect
- 8 his/her share of the work;
- 9 5. To vote and act impartially for the good of the school system;
- 10 6. To accept the will of the majority vote in all cases and give support to the resulting action;
- 11 7. To represent the Board and the school system to the public in such a way as to promote both interest
- 12 and support; and
- 13 8. To refer complaints to the Director of Schools and to abstain from individual counsel and action in
- 14 regard to staff members.
