- 5 2. Schools must be clean, safe, drug free, disciplined, appropriately staffed, and well equipped for all
- 6 students and teachers.
- 7 3. A strong sense of self-worth and dignity is essential for families, students, community, staff and
- 8 teachers.
- 9 4. The partnership should be committed to the recruitment and retention of quality employees.
- 10 5. All students and employees should experience some joy in each day.
- 11 6. Schools are learning communities where all partners are life-long learners.
- 12 7. Our school system, as a steward of public funds, shall be accountable to the citizens it serves.
- 13 8. Students learn in different ways and at different rates and should be challenged to achieve high
- 14 standards.
- 15 9. Schools will succeed, if they have clear instructional goals, high expectations, and highly motivated
- 16 staff.
- 17 10. Schools and families have a responsibility to help students develop physically, socially, emotionally, and
- 18 artistically as well as in academic skills and citizenship.
- 19 11. Students who have regular attendance, caring staff and supportive families, and who complete high
- 20 school will become more productive citizens.
