1 Under the leadership and direction of the Director of Schools and the instructional supervisors, a unified
2 curriculum shall be developed within the statewide curriculum framework for the school system in each subject
3 area of grades K-12 and presented to the Board for adoption.¹
4

5 At least one copy of the complete curriculum shall be placed in each school or made available electronically.
6 Teachers shall have access to the portion which pertains to their area of teaching. New teachers shall be given
7 an appropriate copy and briefed by administration on its content in relation to the total curriculum.

9 IMPLEMENTATION

10
11 The primary responsibility for the effective operation of the curriculum program and activities shall be delegated
12 to the Director of Schools.
13

14 The school principals and instructional supervisors shall be responsible for administering the established
15 instructional programs and for the development and supervision of a coordinated plan for the improvement of
16 instruction in their schools.
