1 The Director of Schools shall develop an administrative procedure to establish a system of grading and
2 assessment for evaluating and recording student progress and to measure student performance in conjunction
3 with Board adopted content standards for grades K-12.¹ The grading/assessment system shall follow all
4 applicable statutes and rules and regulations of the State Board of Education. The grading/assessment system
5 shall be uniform district-wide at grade levels 3-12. The Director of Schools shall have the authority to establish
6 and operate ungraded and/or unstructured classes in grades K-3.²

8 The Director of Schools shall submit a copy of the grading, reporting and assessment systems to the Board
9 before the system is implemented. These approved guidelines shall be communicated annually to students and
10 parents/guardians.¹

12 Points shall not be deducted from academic grade due to conduct.

13
14 A student may repeat any course in which an "F" is made if the schedule of the student allows it. The
15 subsequent grade, if higher than an "F", will be placed on the student's transcript and the "F" will be removed.
16 The course taken over must be the same course code number as the course which was failed and the course
17 must be retaken in a Wilson County School. Wilson County Schools will not remove an "F" from a transcript
18 unless the course is retaken in a Wilson County School.

20 Students attempting to retake the previously failed course somewhere other than within the Wilson County
21 School system must obtain prior approval by their principal for purposes of removing the original F.
