1 The code of conduct is applicable to all students in grades K-12 attending school in the Wilson County School
2 System. This discipline code shall apply at all times, at any school related activity, either on campus or off, or
3 while being transported to or from a school related activity. Violations or infractions of the rules listed may lead
4 to suspension or expulsion. In no way shall this list of violations or consequences be considered all inclusive.

6 The *Code of Conduct* shall be the minimum discipline applied for any offense, notwithstanding any other policies
7 or procedures, athletic or otherwise, that may have been adopted by any other schools. No other policy shall
8 supersede this policy. Tennessee State Law gives the principal, or his/her designee, the authority to discipline
9 students who violate school board policies or school rules. In instances where violations are severe enough to
10 warrant doing so, the principal may choose to bypass one or more of the preliminary steps. Numerous violations
11 of different offenses may be considered cumulative by the principal/designee, and appropriate consequences
12 may be assigned.

14 A record of all disciplinary action shall be maintained on each student. Each offense shall be recorded,
15 including the date, offense and disciplinary action taken.
