1 Through the use of state guidelines the Director of Schools shall be responsible for:

- 2
- 3 1. Developing and implementing an appropriate curriculum on alcohol and drug education for students;
- 4 2. Providing adequate information and training for all staff personnel as appropriate to their
- 5 responsibilities;
- 6 3. Implementing the relevant portions of the Drug Free Youth Act;¹
- 7 4. Developing administrative rules and guidelines for the school system to effectively respond to alcohol
- 8 and drug situations that may occur at school or school sponsored events; and
- 9 5. Providing notification to parents and students that compliance with this policy is mandatory.

11 Students will not consume, possess, use, sell, distribute or be under the influence of illegal drugs or alcoholic
12 beverages in school buildings or on school grounds at any time, in school vehicles or buses, or at any school
13 sponsored activity, function or event whether on or off school grounds. This includes but is not limited to abuse
14 of inhalants and prescription drugs.²

15
16 Disciplinary sanctions will be imposed on students who violate standards of conduct required by this policy.
17 Such sanctions will be consistent with local, state and federal laws, up to and including suspension/expulsion as
18 well as referral for prosecution.³

19
20 Information about drug and alcohol counseling and rehabilitation programs will be made available through the
21 school.
