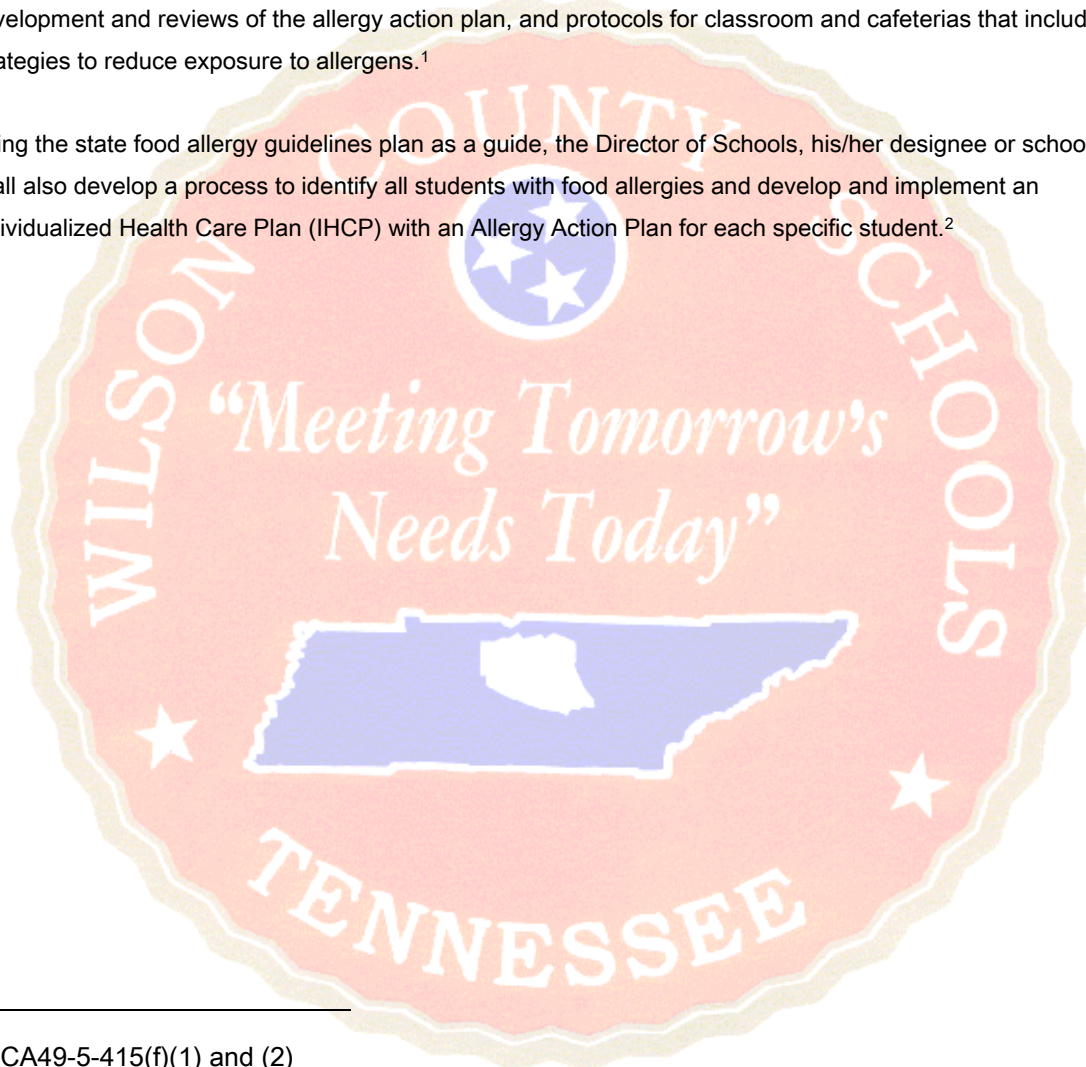


# Wilson County Board of Education

1 The Director of Schools, his/her designee or school nurse shall develop and maintain an Emergency Allergy  
2 Response Plan that meets state guidelines for managing students with life threatening allergies. The Plan shall  
3 include measures to reduce exposure to allergens and procedures to treat allergic reactions. Components of  
4 the plan shall include, but are not limited to; education and training of personnel, recordkeeping/documentation,  
5 development and reviews of the allergy action plan, and protocols for classroom and cafeterias that include  
6 strategies to reduce exposure to allergens.<sup>1</sup>

8 Using the state food allergy guidelines plan as a guide, the Director of Schools, his/her designee or school nurse  
9 shall also develop a process to identify all students with food allergies and develop and implement an  
10 Individualized Health Care Plan (IHCP) with an Allergy Action Plan for each specific student.<sup>2</sup>
