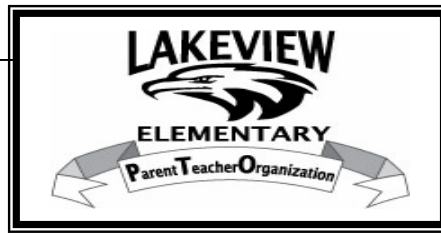


Mission Statement

The Fall Festival is our largest fundraiser for the year and we are really thankful for the great leadership and support we've enjoyed over the years. We've made a few changes to the festival and have incorporated the feedback we've received over the past year to provide a wonderful day for our Lakeview community. Here are a few highlights:

Breakfast is Served – We'll be expanding our breakfast service this year and offering breakfast biscuits and donuts for your morning enjoyment. These items will be available in the Snack Bar and can be purchased with 2 tickets (donuts or juice) to 4-6 tickets (breakfast biscuits).



Lunch – Lunch plates will be catered by Larriviere's! They will be cooking our hamburgers and hot dogs this year, and we're excited to have the professionals preparing our meals. Meal service will be in the tent outside the front doors. Note, you must have a meal voucher (not cash or tickets) to purchase the meals. These vouchers are available via pre-sale (check your child's folder) or in the office the day of the festival. Prices are \$4 for the hamburger plates and \$3 for the hot dog plates.

Silent Auction – Our popular Silent Auction is moving into the cafeteria this year to allow you more room to view the items and make your bids. We know you'll enjoy the extra 'elbow room' and we look forward to the monies we'll raise for our children.

Stroller Check – Thanks to our Suggestion Box, we've also added a Stroller Check right outside the front doors. For no charge, you can check your strollers and enjoy the inside activities.

Great Music – Our talented DJ, Mr. Brian Bayliss, will return outside the front door to provide entertainment, music, announcements, and announce our hourly Festival Volunteer drawings.

We are optimistic we'll have a beautiful, crisp (rain free) day for our festival. But rain or shine, the festival will go on, as scheduled.
