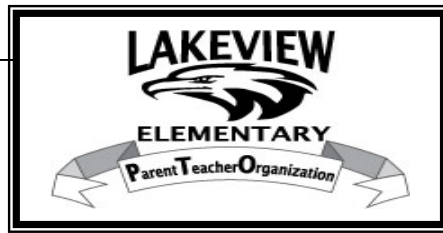


Mission Statement
