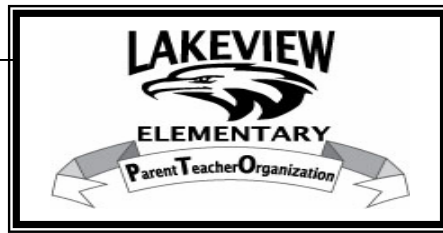


Mission Statement
